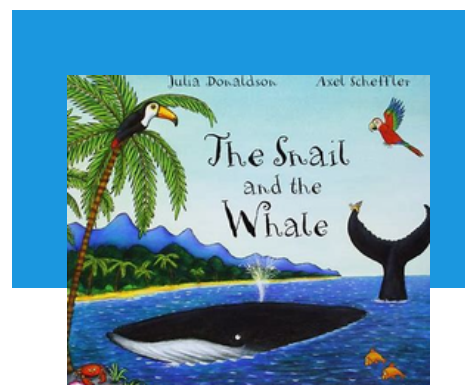


## What is happening next week?
