What is happening next week?

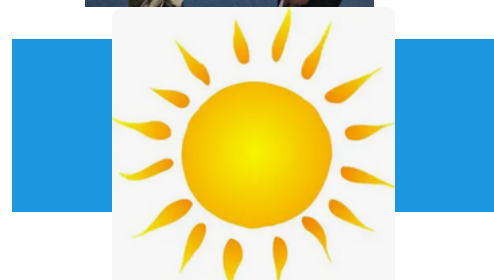
Years 5, 6 and 2 have a workshop from the NSPCC on Monday to help them Speak Out and Stay Safe.
