Year 1 – Blue

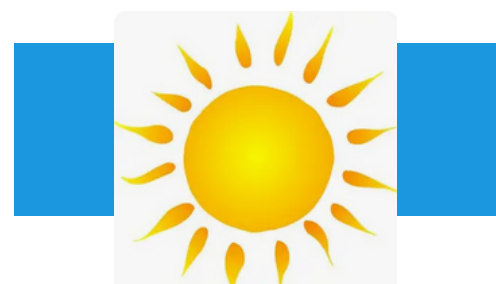
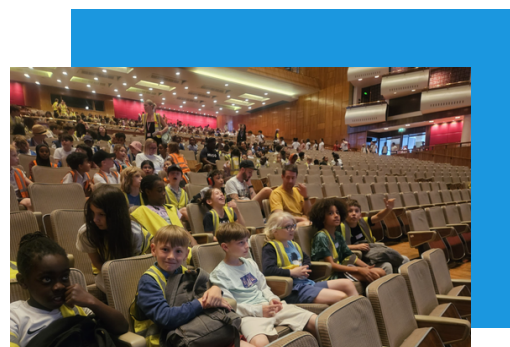
Year 2 – Green
