What is happening next week?

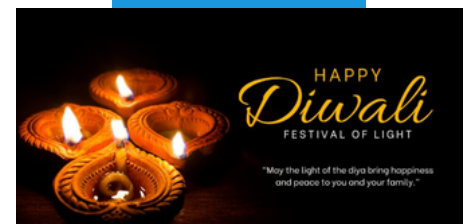
Year 5 are going to the British Museum to look at some primary sources of information about Ancient Greece.

On Friday morning, the school will come together for a work sharing assembly to celebrate our learning during Black History Month.



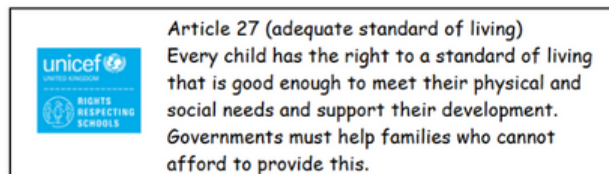
LOST PROPERTY
