The school grounds are looking beautiful as the blossom is in all its glory! Reception have made the most of this by using flowers to print onto fabric with some beautiful results.

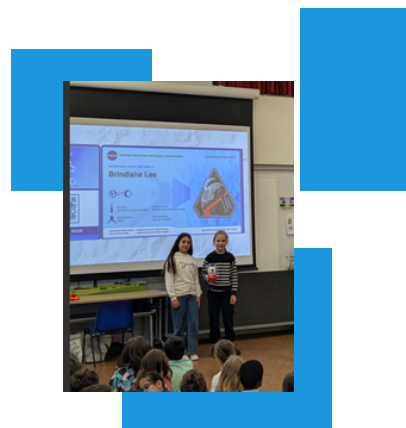
