Why is good attendance so important?

We know there is a link between poor attendance at school and lower academic achievement yet every school year we receive requests for absence in term time for reasons that are not **exceptional**.

New learning takes place every day and children need to be there in order to keep up. It is very difficult for a child to keep up with their peers when they regularly miss days or are absent for a longer period of time.

We do monitor absence patterns very closely and we follow up on all absences. Any child whose attendance is below 90% is considered by the Government to be a **persistent absentee** and their attendance is referred to the local authority Education Welfare Officer. Schools are in a position to issue fines which could be as much as £1,000.

School terms account for only 39 weeks leaving 13 whole weeks of holiday each year.
